Summary of last year's event

On Saturday, May 24th, 2008, the SCAN Foundation held its 2nd Annual 5K Skin Cancer Awareness community educational event in Atlanta at Perimeter Place. More than 500 participants registered, almost doubling our inaugural event. Contributing to the success of SOS 2008, was the volunteer participation of board certified dermatologists from around the metro Atlanta area who provided complimentary spot skin checks. They screened more than 175 individuals, found one melanoma and several basal cell carcinomas and several other pre cancerous lesions. Not only were they able to provide a valuable, potentially life-saving service, the dermatologists enjoyed a great day of fun and fellowship with their colleagues. Participants were provided bags with valuable coupons from Perimeter Place venues and samples of Blue Lizard and Copertone sunscreen, Olay Complete .

AM750 WSB radio station brought their van out, and DJ Ray Bernal provided great music and gave out prizes to people who answered key skin cancer questions correctly.
